China Airlines Successfully Launched Taipei-Miyazaki Route

China Airlines successfully launched a new flight service between Taipei and Mizayaki on 21 January. Sun Huang-hsiang, President of CAL, officiated at the launch ceremony which was attended by representatives of various Taiwan travel agencies.

CAL operates a direct flight between Taipei and Miyazaki every Thursday and Sunday. A Boeing 737-800 aircraft is used for the flights. Miyazaki is situated in the southeastern part of Kyushu, Japan. It is renowned for its warm and sunny weather and rich culture. Often called the birthplace of Japanese mythology, it was also the home of the first emperor of Japan.

With the opening of the Miyazaki route, CAL has increased its services to Japan to 81 flights per week, with a total of eight destinations, including Sapporo, Tokyo, Nagoya, Osaka, Hiroshima, Fukuoka, Miyazaki, and Okinawa.
